

4. POWERS

The Charity has the following powers, which may be exercised only in promoting the Objects:

- 4.1.1 to promote and advertise the Charity's activities.
- 4.1.2 To provide a sound education and equip them with skills to successfully face the challenges of modern day society. Thus, making them valuable contributors to their society.
- 4.1.3 to raise funds solely for the Charity.
- 4.1.4 to publish or distribute information regarding the Charity
- 4.1.5 to encourage international co-operation with other Charities and NGOs.
- 4.1.6 to co-operate with other bodies.
- 4.1.7 to establish regional branches if need be and overseas sections whether autonomous or not.
- 4.1.8 to arrange and provide for or join in arranging and providing for the holding of exhibitions, meetings, conferences, lectures, seminars and other similar activities.
- 4.1.9 to raise funds for the Charity.
- 4.1.10 to set aside funds for special purposes or as reserves against future expenditure.
- 4.1.11 every transaction is reported promptly to the Trustees
- 4.1.12 To enter into contracts to provide services to or on behalf of other bodies
- 4.1.13 to do anything else within the law which promotes or helps to promote the Objects.
